Parking/Transportation:

Parking is located at the Dominion Energy Public Parks on both sides of the dam. Parking lots will open at 4:15 p.m. All vehicles entering the parking lots must display a ticket to the event and a parking pass. All attendees will receive a parking pass via email. This pass does not guarantee parking at either location. Shuttles will take attendees from parking lots to the entrance of the event starting at 4:45 p.m.

Can I take an Uber/Taxi/Lyft to Dining On The Dam?

We encourage attendees to consider other forms of transportation because parking is limited. Uber/ Lyft or taxis will only be allowed to drop off in both the Lexington and Irmo parking lots.
